Brief History

The KodaRoamers was formed organized in September 1944 by Lorena Medbery and sixteen charter members. The aim of this photography group, according to Mike Lux's Highlights, was "to create interest in color photography – both movies and still photography – and promote better pictures and travel after World War II." The group joined the Photographic Society of America (PSA) in 1944. KodaRoamers joined the Central Illinois Camera Club Association in 1964.

In addition to club contests, KodaRoamers mount exhibitions and hold workshops on aspects of photography and technology. In 2003, the club transitioned to the new digital format in lieu of slides. Their first digital projector was purchased in 2004, and competitions had both a digital and a slide division. KodaRoamers transitioned to all-digital in 2012.

Meetings, programs, and salons are held annually. Exhibitions, such as the 2014 "Film Noir" exhibit at the McLean County Arts Center, are organized by KodaRoamers. The club began its 70th year in September 2014 with 79 members. "Highlights of the Past Decade" by Mike Lux found in Box 2, folder 1, provides descriptions of club memberships, locations for meetings, and other details.

Scope

The collection includes yearly membership directories from 1950 through 2015 (a few years missing); minutes from club meetings; information about salons and lists of winners; descriptions of various club trips; newspaper clippings regarding members photographic activities and awards, obituaries, and noteworthy club events.

Box and Folder Inventory

Box 1:

Box 1 contains black 3-ring notebooks/binders (7" x 9") containing minutes (most handwritten) of meetings of the KodaRoamers Club. Some pages include newspaper clippings and ephemera (not itemized in this finding aid) related to the club or to club members. Minutes are organized by academic year. Note: Minutes covering 1994-2015 apparently were integrated into individual scrapbooks (see list below).

Jan 2006 – Sept 2010 – light blue scrapbook, floral image on front, 12.5" x 14.5" with ephemera pasted or taped to paper leaves. Items include meeting minutes from March 2006 through May 2010; invitation cards to meetings; copies of CICCA Courier newsletter; salon listings; miscellaneous *Pantagraph* newspaper clippings regarding club activities and members activities and obituaries; some members' funeral programs; group photo dated September 2008.

June 2010 – May 2015 –3-ring binder, black cloth boards, 12.5" x 15" with ephemera encased in plastic sleeves. Items include meeting minutes from September 2010 through May 2011, when apparently minutes were discontinued; invitation cards to dinner meetings; copies of notes/emails; copies of CICCA Courier newsletter; miscellaneous *Pantagraph* newspaper clippings regarding club activities and members activities and obituaries; and club bylaws c.2015.
