Brief History

In 1924, William V McKinzie (1897-1980) wed Mary C Welsh (1900-1985). W.V. co-chaired the McLean County Ration Board during WWII. He was also president of a Chicago bank and a director of National Bank of Bloomington. McKinzie participated in multiple veterans organizations. He and wife Mary were active in Holy Trinity Church.

Son John F. McKinzie (1925-1981) attended Holy Trinity High School in Bloomington and graduated from University of Illinois with a bachelors and later a doctor of law degree. He was president of Sigma Chi fraternity in college.

In January 1944, he became a machine gunner in a US infantry unit in Europe and received a Bronze Star for his battle heroism. Later, he was on the staff an inspector general.

John entered the insurance industry as a claims lawyer and eventually became chief operating officer of Meridian Mutual Insurance in Indianapolis. He wed Mickey McCurley in April 1952.

Son James W. McKinzie became a physician and lived in Ventura, CA.
