Brief History

The McLean Home Bureau changed its name to McLean County Homemakers Extension Association on July 1, 1962. The association is for development of home making through educational monthly meetings. Attendees review lessons on how to make something or work a new technology. They help organize programs in their area. In 2001 the group changed its name again to McLean County Association for Home and Community Education (HCE).

Scope

The McLean County Homemakers Extension Association contains 6 boxes with 183 folders, four scrapbooks, four guest books, and four financial books.

Box 1 contains guest books and scrapbooks.

Box 2 contains newsletters, consumer cues, lessons, correspondences, and unit officer's listings.

Box 3 contains unit minutes and attendance lists.

Box 4 contains unit members, membership reports, council appointments, advisor's reports, committee assignments, job descriptions, unit summaries and installation, annual reports, semis progress reports, annual narrative evaluation report, agreement, HEA week, program of works, plan of works, sister city information, golden HEA, IHEF report forms, topic statement and unit meeting articles, meeting and program information, special activities, officers orientation, HEA 80th anniversary.

Box 5 contains constitution and by-laws, pennies for friendship, Jefferson award, Ewing memorial scholarship fund, quilt quest task force, great McLean County cookie machine, food labeling, recipes/food related articles, health department, recreation, activities, flyers, pamphlets, booklets, arts and craft projects, quilt, Prairie Crafts Day II, and contains membership unit cards.

Box 6 contains financial items.

Box 1

Guestbook 1: First Reunion of McLean County H.E.A. Members of 50 Years or Longer

and Golden H.E.A.'ers Luncheon -- April 30, 1979 - April 25, 1984

This guest book is in good condition. The cover has a little discoloration. The cover is an ivory cover with "guests" written in cursive with a gold color. There are also some flowers in gold on the cover. A little less than half of the book is filled out. It has the date, name, and address of the members.

Guestbook 2: No name or date

This guest book is in good condition. The cover has very little wear. It is a white cover with "guest" written in silver. There is only one and a half pages filled out. The rest of the book is left blank. There is no indication on what this guestbook was used for and at what time. It has names and some addresses, but mostly what town they lived in.

Guestbook 3: McLean County H.E.A. Quilt Show -- Sept 23 + 24, 1983

This guest book is in excellent condition. It has a red and black cover with "guest" written in silver. There is a design close to the spine. The majority of the book is filled out with names and addresses.

Guestbook 4:

This guestbook has some wear to it. The cover is torn off on the bottom right corner. The guestbook is brown with "royal" symbols on the cover. There is a paperclip slipcover page on the inside. The first page has "Property of the Normal Home Bureau" handwritten. The first and second pages are stuck together, but there seems to be nothing written on the pages. There are several pages with the date, name, and residence of the guest. Dates range from September 14, 1953 - October 2, 1995. There are only a few names for each year. The pages seem to have discoloration, and one page has strange red splotches on it. The majority of the guestbook is left blank.

Scrapbook 1: McLean County Homemakers Extension Association

September 1971- August 1974

This large scrapbook (SB) is in good condition and it sports a white/gray cover with gold "stars" and gold "Scrap Book" written in the middle. The SB is tied together by a brown string. Articles and pictures, with the dates September 1971 - August 1973, are from "The Daily Pantograph", "McLean County Farm Bureau News", "The IHEF Newsletter", "The McLean Lens", "The Normalite", "Chenoa Clipper Times", and 4-H articles are on white pages in the center of the book.

Some of the pages are no longer attached. The articles are identified with the newspaper and has a date written above. Some pages have numbers on the bottom. In the middle of the book starts a new section, and the page numbers start over. This part of the SB has a table of contents and has tabs with the month on them. There are articles, program books, newsletters, pictures, and other news. Some of the items are coming off the pages.

Pictures from "This is Extension", October 1-2, 1971, are labeled besides one. Most of the articles have specific dates either on the article or written above on the SB paper. There are booklets for annual meetings and other miscellaneous items. There is a letter talking about a Home Bureau Scholarship that was given for the first time; also the recipient picture is next to her letter to Mrs. Esposito. There are a few ribbons for awards throughout the SB. Towards the end there are several articles about Margaret Esposito. There is one honoring her on the win of the National Service Award, a couple of pages are about the Yule in December 1973. Towards the end there are more pictures of people dressing up, doesn't seem to indicate what for, but all pictures are identified.

There is an annual meeting booklet that has the agenda, minutes, financial statement, budget, membership report, and advisor reports. On the last page there are three pictures from the Corn Festival 1974 canning booth.

Scrapbook 2: Twin City Home Bureau 1958-1967

This large scrapbook (SB) is in good condition. Some of the pages on the top and bottom are torn. This SB is sporting a green padded cover with faded gold design on the top and bottom. It is held together with a green string. There is a small piece of tape on the front cover that tells the years, but it is faded and hard to read. The spine is worn down by the many times this SB was open.

The first few pages are from 1958 - September 1959. There are some news clippings about the Home Bureau and the various meetings and activities they have done. There is also their membership from 1958-1959. Also includes the McLean Country Home Bureau booklet from September 1, 1958 - September 1, 1959. It features two pages talking about how to diet, counting calories, and exercise.

Next part of the SB deals with September 1959 - August 1960. There are more booklets, articles clippings, and pictures of the same sort. There are cards that are talking about meetings and where they will be held, programs, luncheons, and other activities. There is a new membership list for 1960-1961 (this page is marked with a yellow sticky note). There is a page that has eight different songs, and they look like they have to deal with the Home Bureau.

The third part is from September 1961-September 1962. More newspaper clippings, pictures, cards with meetings and activities. There are articles about the Home Bureau changing their name to Illinois Homemakers Extension Federation or McLean County Home Bureau to McLean County Homemakers Extension Association. There are also booklets for this year. Home Economics Extension Program for McLean County (also in the last part). New membership list, but don't know for sure the date. There is a sheet of paper about the membership rules.

Fourth part is from September 1962-September 1963. Newspaper clippings, articles, pictures, cards. There was not much for this part.

Fifth part is from September 1963-September 1964. Articles, cards, McLean County Homemakers Extension Association 1963, this has two newspaper articles on the inside of the

front and back cover. This also has the First Homemakers Extension Association Newsletter (which is in one of the folders in Box 2).

Sixth part is from September 1964-1965. There are articles and cards.

Seventh part is from September 1965-1966. There are articles, pictures, cards, and booklets.

None of the articles have specific dates.

Scrapbook 3: Twin City Unit HEA 1967-1977

This semi-large scrapbook is in good condition. Some of the pages on the inside are coming apart, or already apart. The cover is off white/gray. In the middle there are crowns with blue, green, and gold coloring. It is held together by a beige string.

The articles and pictures are about lessons, activities, and meetings that the Homemakers Extension Association (HEA) have done. Some of the articles are coming off the pages. There are a few articles talking about awards (Ewing, BPW Career Woman of the Year). One articles talked about Margaret Esposito getting her job in August 1970. She gets the BPW award in October 1971. A little after the middle of the SB, there are some pictures. They all seemed to be identified. There is an annual meeting booklet.

Scrapbook 4: HEA 1977-1979

This medium size scrapbook is not in very good condition. The edges are worn down, and the inside pages are tearing and some of the pages are coming out. This SB is a dark blue cover with vine design all around, and the middle has gold trip and "Scrap Book" in gold. It is held together with a dark blue string.

The first few pages has pictures and they are all identified. The articles are about topics, lessons, meetings, awards, and activities. Half of the newspaper articles are identified (seems to be mostly from the Pantagraph). There is a 1978-1979 and 1979-1980 membership list is in the middle of the SB. Has a few booklets and the last few pages are blank.
