Brief History

The Normal Avenue Neighborhood Club was formed in the Spring of 1931 by Irene Buzzard and Elsie Popejoy. Limited to women in the neighborhood, the club's purpose was informal diversions and connecting with other women in the neighborhood. Since this was at the beginning of the Depression, women often used the meeting times for productive and inexpensive activities, such as mending, knitting, and other needlework, in addition to visiting. During the December 11, 1936, meeting, for example, they listened to Edward VIII make his famous abdication speech "for the woman I love."

Membership in the Normal Avenue Neighborhood Club originally was open to women in the 600 and 700 blocks of the street, though those on Gregory were also invited. The geographic limits of the club were set from Bowles north to the apartments and the four houses on Gregory. Presently, it is open to women on the 800 block of Normal Avenue as well.

The original members of the Club, according to the history written by Elsie Popejoy, included Elsie Popejoy, Irene Buzzard, Bertha Hudelson, Alma King, Audrey Beckman, Esther Ireland, Nita Gray Lusher, Lucille Homes, Maude Harper, Grace Anderson, Minta Stephens, Clara Meyer, Betty Ridenour, and Lelia Odell, with Garnetta Horton joining in the second year.

The collection includes the Club's directories from 1951, minutes of the monthly meetings from 1940 to present, and ephemera.
